Elks 6 hosted a Tribute to Fallen Soldiers Memorial Torch motorcycle ride and had visits with three Gold Star families in the Sacramento area. Since its inception by Warren Williamson in 2009, the ride has honored more than 800 fallen service members across the nation.

Williamson said, "It was our ambition to honor each and every one of these fallen service members, and to graciously acknowledge their service and sacrifice, and to remind each Gold Star family their fallen service member wasn't forgotten."

Williamson continued, "Once the Gold Star American Flag arrives in Washington, DC, on Saturday, May 25, it will go inside Arlington National Cemetery with us to the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier where it will witness Tribute to Fallen Soldiers laying a wreath at this most honorable site."

AROUND THE LODGE

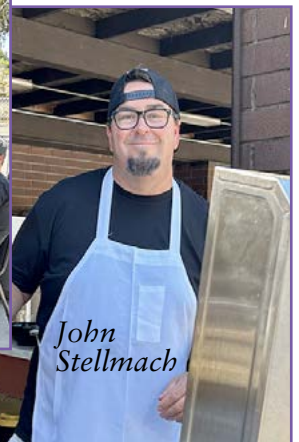
